Evolutions and Inheritance – Game of Survival

To learn that it is a combination of inherited characteristics and the effect of environmental variables that ultimately mould the appearance and behaviour of living things through the process of natural selection. Children analyse fossil records, which show that organisms have changed over millions of years and that many have become extinct.

Animals including Humans - To identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. To recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function. To describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans
